
Quincy College will grant college credit to students from South Shore Vocational Technical High School based on the following criteria:

- Students must meet all requirements for admission into the Quincy College program they choose.
- Students must be South Shore Vocational Technical High School students.
- Students must have graduated, in good standing, from South Shore Vocational Technical High School before articulation credit can be granted.
- Students must have completed the prescribed course of study at South Shore Vocational Technical High School and have received a minimum overall grade of 80%.
- Required high school course must be completed within one year prior to the request for credit.
- This agreement may be terminated in whole or in part by either party giving a full thirty (30) calendar day notice in writing. However, such termination shall not effect with regard to students already eligible or enrolled.


